

Entry Parts I, II, and III

With the proposed October 2018 IT curriculum changes, all career studies certificates and degree specializations are now 100% stackable. (Table 1 shows courses and credits) Currently, there are two IT Specializations as well as three CSC being offered. All credits earned in either specialization are CSC are transferable to the parent degree. In addition, all credits from a sub-credential transfer into the parent degree.

A 2-year course offering schedule/plan has been developed to ensure that there is an appropriate timeframe and availability of courses toward the completion award sub credential prior to the parent degree. (Table 2 shows the courses and their schedule/availability. The highlighted courses are being removed pending approval from the Curriculum Committee, Oct. 2018. Notes are also included.
